

St. Patrick's Day

St. Patrick's Day, feast day (March 17) of St. Patrick, patron saint of Ireland. Born in Roman Britain in the late 4th century, he was kidnapped at the age of 16 and taken to Ireland as a slave. He escaped but returned about 432 CE to convert the Irish to Christianity. By the time of his death on March 17, 461, he had established monasteries, churches, and schools. Many legends grew up around him—for example, that he drove the snakes out of Ireland and used the shamrock to explain the Trinity. Ireland came to celebrate his day with religious services and feasts. Saint Patrick's Day is celebrated on Thursday, March 17, 2022.

It was emigrants, particularly to the United States, who transformed St. Patrick's Day into a largely secular holiday of revelry and celebration of things Irish. Cities with large numbers of Irish immigrants, who often wielded political power, staged the most extensive celebrations, which included elaborate parades. Boston held its first St. Patrick's Day parade in 1737, followed by New York City in 1762. Since 1962 Chicago has colored its river green to mark the holiday. (Although blue was the color traditionally associated with St. Patrick, green is now commonly connected with the day.) Irish and non-Irish alike commonly participate in the "wearing of the green"—sporting an



item of green clothing or a shamrock, the Irish national plant, in the lapel. Corned beef and cabbage are associated with the holiday, and even beer is sometimes dyed green to celebrate the day. Although some of these practices eventually were adopted by the Irish themselves, they did so largely for the benefit of tourists.

BEWARE OF BOFU (CANE) TOADS



As the weather starts to warm and the rainy season commences, we will start to see an uptick in these dangerous toads.

The bofu toad (also known as the cane, giant or marine toad) is a large, nonnative amphibian that has been introduced into Florida. Bofu toads are considered an invasive species and are poisonous to most animals that try to bite or consume them. Bufos are seen mainly during the rainy season (late May to mid-October) and most often at night, near lit

areas, as the bugs attract them. They are seen much less frequently during daylight hours but can be found hiding under vegetation.

Bofu toads are reddish-brown to grayish-brown with a light-yellow or beige belly and can be uniform in color or have darker markings around the body. They have enlarged glands behind the eyes, which angle downward onto the shoulders. The glands secrete a potent milky-white toxin (bufotoxin) as defense against predators including domestic pets. Bofu toads generally range in size from 6 to 9 inches in length. They can be confused with the native southern toad, however, adult bofu toads are much larger than adult southern toads which only grow to a maximum of approximately 3 to 4 inches. Bofu toads do not have ridges across the head, as seen in the southern toad.



First Aid for Bufo Toad Toxin

If your pet licks or otherwise takes the toad into his or her mouth, immediately rinse the mouth with a drippy wet washcloth several times to remove any toxin from the mouth. Do not use a hose to rinse the mouth as water can easily be forced into the lungs, causing more problems. Proceed to the nearest veterinary clinic or emergency clinic as time is of the essence: the smaller the pet or the larger the toad, the greater the risk of toxicity.

Do not attempt to treat this at home. Untreated, the death rate for exposure to Bufo marinus may approach 100%.

Symptoms of Bufo toxin exposure are apparent almost immediately and include:

- Profuse foamy salivation that looks like shaving cream
- Difficulty breathing
- Brick-red gums
- Convulsions
- Paralysis
- Uncoordinated staggering
- Ventricular fibrillation
- Vomiting

Preventing Bufo Toad Exposure to Pets

To avoid attracting toads to areas with pets, do not leave pet food in open dishes in the yard as Bufos are attracted to food and water dishes and may sit in the rim long enough to leave enough toxin to make a pet ill OR CAUSE DEATH. A cat or dog that licks or mouths a Bufo could get a hefty dose of the toad's toxins.

Keeping your dog on a leash and well-supervised when outdoors should be sufficient to prevent Bufo toad toxicity. Carry a flashlight at night so that if the dog seems overly curious about something, you can check it out. These toads don't attack, but a curious dog sniffing or licking the toad can get poisoned as a result.

Colcannon Shepherd's Pie

Ingredients

Filling

1 teaspoon extra-virgin olive oil

1 1/2 pounds ground lamb Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper

1 medium onion, chopped (2 cups)

4 carrots, peeled and cut into 1/4-inch coins (1 1/4 cups)

3 tablespoons tomato paste

1 tablespoon unbleached allpurpose flour

1 cup frozen peas

3/4 cup packed chopped flatleaf parsley

Mash

2 1/2 pounds Yukon Gold potatoes, peeled and cut into 1 1/2-inch pieces

1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil

1 pound Savoy cabbage, thinly sliced (5 cups)

2/3 cup whole milk, warmed

4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted, plus more for brushing



Directions Step 1

Filling: Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Heat a large skillet over medium-high. Swirl in oil. Add lamb; season with 1 teaspoon salt and cook, breaking up into bite-size pieces and stirring occasionally, until browned in places and just cooked through, 7 to 9 minutes. Transfer to a bowl.

Step 2

Remove all but 1 tablespoon fat from skillet; return to medium heat. Add onion and carrots; season with 1 teaspoon salt. Cook, stirring occasionally, until vegetables are softened and golden in places, 6 to 8 minutes. Stir in tomato paste; cook 30 seconds. Stir in flour; cook 1 minute. Return lamb and accumulated juices to skillet. Stir in Worcestershire, broth, and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Bring to a boil, scraping up browned bits from bottom of skillet. Reduce heat to medium-low; simmer until thickened slightly, 1 to 2 minutes. Remove from heat. Stir in pass and parsley. Transfer to a 2-quart baking dish.

Step 3

Mash: In a large pot, cover potatoes with 1 inch of water; add 1 tablespoon salt. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to medium and simmer until tender, 12 to 15 minutes; drain. Return pot to medium heat; swirl in oil. Add cabbage and 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cook, stirring occasionally, until collapsed and tender, 7 to 9 minutes. Return potatoes to pot; mash with a potato masher. Add milk and butter, mashing and stirring until mixture is creamy and cabbage is distributed evenly. Season with salt and pepper. Spread mash evenly over lamb mixture; brush top with butter. Place on a rimmed baking sheet lined with parchment.

Step 4

Bake until golden brown in places and bubbling along edges, 30 to 35 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before serving. Pie can be refrigerated in an airtight container up to 2 days.



LOGGING INTO YOUR RENT MANAGER


Thank you for everyone who has signed up for, and uses Rent Manager to pay your rent. I thought it might be useful to put the log in steps in writing for you, as I know sometimes we forgot the steps from one month to the next:

Step 1: Log into your account. This is the link you must use. Always put it in the top address bar, not the middle search bar in google.

Step 2: Change to location to Lakes by clicking on the down arrow and selecting Lakes. Enter your usemame (your email address), and then your password:



Step 3: Select Make a Payment, and then Select entire amount. You must check the box acknowledging the convenience fee for CREDIT OR DEBIT CARD PAYMENTS ONLY. ACH (Checking accounts) do not have any fees.

Step 4: On ce you have done this, you will get a confirmation that your payment has gone through. If you do not, see a confirmation, check your dashboard to see if there is a balance. If it does not say \$0.00, your rent payment has not gone through and you will have to repeat these steps.






